## Best Practice-2

### Community Outreach programme

#### Context

The NSS is a "National Social Scheme" that works on the motto "Not Me But You". The NSS Unit conducts various welfare, upliftment, and awareness programmes for the tribal people. They do not have knowledge about education, social problems, dropouts and stagnation. The NSS Unit focuses on the overall progress of the tribal villagers, who are still restrained by various factors. With the lack of information, ignorance, and outreach awareness programs, the lives of these villagers are still encircled by various problems. This grim ground reality got reflected when the pupil-teacher conducted a special awareness campaign in the village **Inderwatand**. They face various problems like illiteracy; health hazards related to unhygienic living conditions, superstition, adherence to tribal modes of farming, negligence, etc. are some of the issues restraining the progress of the villagers that the NSS Unit is organising an awareness campaign, especially targeting these issues to bring out the change in the perception of the tribal villagers.

#### Objectives

- To make the villagers encouraged and aware of the need to learn the art of living.
- To develop the bond between pupil-teacher with the tribal villagers through the NSS programs.
- To adopt a village, to maintain consistency in conducting social awareness programmes.
- To develop organizational and communication skills among the pupil-teachers

#### Practice

The following measures have been taken to achieve the best practices:

- Awareness on social evils.
- Blanket & Cloth Distribution
- Computer literacy Programme
- Health awareness

1. Pupil-teacher and N.S.S. volunteers conducted a specific awareness programmes to collect the information from the villagers of **Inderwatand**
2. The analysis of the outcome of the programmes which helped for solving the problem of villagers
3. A special NSS camp was organized at the village with 50 volunteers, apart from performing their routine activities, started communicating, interacting with the villagers to enhance their participation in the lectures and other activities organized for them.
4. Daily lecture series, guidance sessions followed by question-answer session, cultural programmes, enlighten programmes, training sessions etc. gave comprehensive nature to the campaign.
5. Mr. Saurabh Sharma, Asst. Prof. delivered a lecture on Eradication of Superstition-Need of an hour, aiming at bringing in awareness among the villagers about superstitions and blind faiths.
6. A special training session on Yoga and Pranayam to highlight its significance to improve the life style was conducted by Mr. Saurabh Sharma.
7. NSS Volunteers and the staff members along with the villagers carried out a cleanliness drive lasting till the end of the campaign.

Evidence of Success:

1. Grizzly college of Education has organized NSS activities according to the annual calendar provided by affiliating university Vinoba Bhave.
2. NSS unit of Grizzly College of Education has celebrated Environment day, Earth day to sensitize the students towards Environment conservation.
3. NSS unit of Grizzly College of Education has also organized swacchata campaign in the adopted village Inderwatand.
4. NSS unit of Grizzly College of Education has distributed Mask, Sanitizer and also distributed Blanket and warm clothes in the winter season.

5. A Sanitation drive was also conducted among the villagers.
6. NSS volunteers created awareness for vaccination against COVID-19.
7. A change in villagers attitude towards cleanliness was clearly evident.
8. Calls and invitations were received from the villagers to the college to organize more training and guidance sessions on Yoga and Pranayam.
9. The participated students appeared more sensitized and motivated as their participation in other social activities, conducted by college enhanced.
10. The organizational skill among the students appeared to be enhanced while organizing various programmes in the college.

#### Obstacle

- Participation of the villagers was less during day time.
- It seemed rather difficult to enlighten the tribal villagers on the issue of superstitions and blind faith especially women folk.
- Attitude of most of the tribal villagers to blame the government machinery for every wrong led to dull response in the beginning of the campaign.
