Chairman's Message

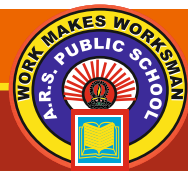

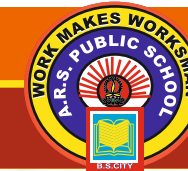

24. MODE OF PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES :-

- All School fees are payable in advance either in cash or by cheque before 20th of every month.
- If the fee is not paid by the due date, a late fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged. If fees are not paid for consecutive three months student's name will be struck off the school rolls and re-admission of the student may be done on payment of all the dues and re-admission fee of Rs.200/- after the approval of the Principal.
- Fees may paid by A/C Payee **Cheque** drawn in favour of A.R.S. Public School Bokaro Steel City or in **Cash/through swipe machine**.
- The date of presentation of the cheque will be treated as the date of payment provided the cheque in not dishonoured.
- Dishonoured cheque will be treated under the category of non- payment of fees.
- In case of dishonoured cheque due to any reason a fine of Rs. 500 along with the outstanding fees in cash shall be deposited in the accounts Section. Therefore, Parents are advised to be careful while making payment of the fees through cheques.
- Only those Cheque / D.D. is accepted for payment of school fees, which is drawn on any scheduled bank situated in Bokaro Steel City. Parents may kindly keep each of the receipts in safe custody and produce these to the school in proof of their payment.

The school reserves the rights to amend the fee structure time to time.

27. PARENTS TEACHER MEETING:-

Parents Teacher Meetings are held on Saturday as per schedule given in school Diary. Parents are requested to attend the school on the scheduled date and meet with the class teacher for the progress of their wards. Parents are the member of the school family. Hence, they are also important pillar for the development of the school as a whole by giving their valuable suggestions. Parents are also requested to meet with the principal for any issue with prior appointment.

**14. LIBRARY:-**

The school has set up a large library with reference materials such as books on various subjects, interactive CD's for computer based training, audio and video materials and has a large number of journals & magazines.

15. COMPUTER CENTRE :-

Computer Skills are becoming an integral part of any profession. Apart from basic skills, advanced knowledge on the use of various computer software are given. A large number of students participate in Cyber Olympiad, Informatics Olympiad, Web designing & Creativity Olympiad.

16. LABORATORIES:-

Ample opportunities for the modern day methodology is provided in the forms of practical classes. "Learning by doing" is given to the children to develop understanding of the concept-thinking & analytical skills, experiment on a range of scientific equipment through the Mathematics & Science laboratories. To enrich the knowledge of language and social science there are provisions of language and social science laboratories.

17. COMMUNITY LIVING, CAMP & EXCURSION:-

The School aims at fostering qualities such as collective work, co-operative attitude, fellow feelingness, appreciation of rural culture etc. The School arranges such activities to bring in that unique dimension among the students by organising camp, Excursion and picnic.

18. EXTRACURRICULAR – IGNITING THE SPIRIT :-

Students club help to identify, nurture and bring to lime light in extracurricular talents such as music, debating, elocution, quiz, sports,, drama, art etc, which are nurtured in systematic way and self esteem is encouraged by participation in competitive events (Intra School & Inter School).

19. HOUSE SYSTEM:-

In order to promote a competitive and healthy team spirit in sports and allied activities, the whole school is divided into 4 houses namely – VASUDHA (Yellow), PAYODHI (Green), ACHAL (Red) and VYOM (Blue). Based on all the activities of the school including studies, the House acquires points in proportion to the performance of its members. Several Inter-House competitions are conducted throughout the academic session viz. indoor and outdoor games, debate, recitation, speech, quiz, essay writing, art & craft, solo song, group song, group dance etc.

20. STUDENT COUNCIL:-

Freedom and responsibility have to be learnt slowly, freely and accepted in an atmosphere in which a student exercises judgement and makes free choices about matters appropriate to their age and level of understanding. Election nominations on democratic principles are conducted for the school council committee members.

21. PHYSICAL EDUCATION & SPORTS :-

Sound physique for a sound mind is very essential. To build healthy body among the children, the school organizes different games and sports activities throughout a year on regular basis. This will lead the students to develop the sense of sportsmanship, co-operative attitudes, sympathy, discipline, punctuality etc. The school has a huge playground to organize all the major games and sports.

22. TRANSPORT FACILITY:-

The school has its own buses and students can avail transport facility subject to the availability of seats. Every student will be provided with a bus pass to avail the transport facility subject to payment of bus fee in advance. Only those students who are having bus passes will be allowed in the school bus. Students who will avail bus facility un-authorisedly will liable to financial punishment.

The school will accept at least one month's notice (30days) from the parents/guardians for the discontinuation of the bus facility.

23. SCHOOL CANTEEN :-

Canteen is being run in the school campus for the children of the school. Fresh food items are available there. It is an additional amenity. Students are requested to bring healthy home-made food items from their homes.

2. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:-

- To develop the spirit of sportsmanship and to appreciate the achievements of others.
- To teach students some common skills to enable them to be useful citizens of the world society.
- To develop the sense of national integration among the children.

3. CURRICULUM:-

This school is preparing its students under the syllabus prescribed by N.C.E.R.T./C.B.S.E. for All India Secondary/Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the Central Board of secondary Education. Medium of instruction is English for all the classes but school lays an equal emphasis on Hindi also.

Except normal curriculum G.K, Music, Moral Science, Art and Craft, drawing, computer science, Health & Physical Education are taught from LKG to Std. XII. This school has its senior secondary wing with the streams of Science and Commerce.

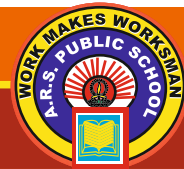

4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:-

A Candidate seeking admission to School shall get himself/herself registered at the School office with duly filled-in application form [available at school counter] on or before the last date of registration.

Admission is done on the basis of lottery /first come first serve basis/counselling.

ADMISSION TO STD II – STD IX

For classes II and onwards no students will be admitted without submitting the School Leaving Certificate/Transfer certificate of the School attended last. **Admission will be based upon the vacancies available in the School and the performance in the admission test.**

ADMISSION TO STD . XI

Prospectus and Admission Form for admission to std. XI will be available at the school counter from the month of April. Last date of registration , date of admission , eligibility criteria and selection procedure will be displayed on the notice board of the school.

REQUIREMENT OF DOCUMENTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- 1] For Nursery to Std. I *-Original Birth Certificate from Govt. Reg. Office along with Xerox Copy.*
- 2] For Std. II to Std. IX *-Original Transfer Certificate from any Recognised school.*
- 3] For Std. XI & XII
 - a) Transfer Certificate (Original Copy)
 - b) Character Certificate (Original Copy)
 - c) Xerox Copy of class X Mark sheet.
 - d) Migration Certificate [Original Copy](applicable for the students other than C.B.S.E. Board)
 - e) Recent Black & White photographs, three copies (passport sized) with the name & date of photography.

Note: 1. Date of Birth once entered cannot be subsequently changed.
2. Application is liable to be rejected if these instructions are not followed fully.
3. The syllabus of the Admission test is the portion of the immediate previous class. For example to admit a child in Std.II, questions will be asked from the syllabus of Std.I. Generally, knowledge of English , Science and mathematics are tested.

GUIDELINES FOR TAKING ADMISSION IN STD.XI

Every candidate seeking admission to class XI may register from March onwards. They are asked to submit the filled-in registration form along with copy of the pre-board exam. of Xth. Those who fail to submit the registration form by the due date will not be considered for admission. Based upon the marks obtained in class X Board examination, a list of shortlisted candidates will be published for an interaction. Based upon the Xth class Board Examination Marks and performance in the interaction, a list of finally selected candidates will be published for the admission of Class XI. Candidates are required to come to School immediately on receiving the Board Result.

5. WITHDRAWAL:-

- a) If a student remains absent for continuously three months without prior permission, it will be considered as a left out case and his/her Roll will be struck off from the Class Register. In this case, Re-Admission will be made only by the payment of Rs. 200/- as Re-Admission charge along with monthly fine.
- b) If the Tuition Fee of a student remains unpaid for continuous three months, the Name/Roll will be struck off and Re- Admission will be made only on the payment of Rs. 200/- as Re- Admission charge along with monthly fine.
- c) A student may be given forced T.C. on the ground of indiscipline, unsatisfactory progress in work, repeated detention in the same class.
- d) **A written application must be submitted 15 days in advance to the school by the Parents/Guardians for the Transfer Certificate on the desired date.**
- e) Transfer Certificate will be issued only after the clearance of all the dues.



Yellow Card - Serious offence which reflect adversely on student's Conduct, e.g., breaking bounds, disobedience, telling lies, indicate the award of yellow Card which deprives the offender of availing any privileges in the school for a week. He/She will not be allowed to attend any programme, picnic or outing while on a yellow card. The award of three Yellow cards in an academic year in quick succession may lead to the expulsion of the offender from the school on disciplinary ground.

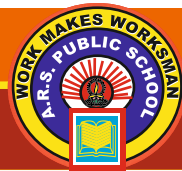
12. GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS:-

The school believes in discipline and firmness. Slackness, disobedience and disregard of rules will not be tolerated and any work or action likely to lower the image of the school is regarded as a breach of the school discipline. The school reserves the right to expel students whose diligence or progress in studies is considered unsatisfactory and/or whose conduct is harmful to other students. Immorality, in subordination, contempt of authority and breaking bounds are always sufficient reasons for immediate expulsion or rustication.

- Parents are requested not to enter the class rooms to see their children or teachers during school hours without the permission of the principal.
- They are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address or telephone numbers.
- Leave for half day should not be asked for security reason. In emergency, written permission must be taken from the Principal through the class teacher and the bus in-charge.
- Children, when sick, should not be sent to school to attend tests/classes.
- Attention of parents is drawn to the fact that criticism of the teacher or school in the presence of their children should be scrupulously avoided because it causes the students to lose respect for their teachers with the consequent failure to learn from them. It further retards their progress.
- Parents may grant pocket money very judiciously to the students. The pocket money should not exceed rupees ten per day.
- If there is any legitimated complaint, please meet the principal at once or write in a separate letter addressed to the Principal to look into these matters personally.
- Any communication made by the parents/ guardians should be addressed to the Principal and not to the class teachers and all correspondence from the school to the parents must be through the principal.
- The report card is an important document and should be kept safely. If the report card is lost, a replacement will be made on payment of Rs.50/-.
- Name, admission number, class, section and house of the students should clearly be marked on their belongings.
- Parents are requested to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality, discipline and by taking interest in their home work . They should check the SCHOOL DIARY every day and to see whether the home work and other instructions are given. In case of small children, the parents are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any notice/invitation has been issued. Care must be taken of all school properties and any damage caused by a student will be made student conceded. In addition a fine will be imposed for the offence.
- It is not advisable to bring to school cash and valuable articles like expensive watches, fountain pens, transistors, tape recorders, calculators, jewellery, Mobile phones, I-pods etc. In case of any loss of valuables or other articles the school authorities will try their best to trace but shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
- The students should be recognized not only by their School Uniform but also by their good conduct and behaviour as students of A.R.S. Public School.

In order to develop moral values among the students, the school begins with morning assembly with patriotic songs. Importance is laid to the universal and eternal values. Children are exposed to spiritual heritage of India. Assembly includes thought for the day with brief explanation by a student or a teacher, news reading, announcement etc. concluding with national anthem is a regular agenda.

Eminent scholars and personalities are invited to deliver the lectures for the benefit of the students of senior classes and to make them aware of different careers. The purpose of this programme is to make the students aware for their future career and also to expose them to the latest development in different fields.



03. Performance of the year: The year's record of work consists in the day to day written work, including completion of homework and daily lessons and an average performance in non-academic activities.

4. A student who uses unfair means and receives or extends assistance in any form during tests will be given zero in the subject and a warning letter. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal of the student. A student who repeats the same class twice will not be allowed in any case to continue for the third year.

Note: There will be preparatory holidays of 15 days for the students of class – X & XII before the commencement of Board Examination and one day for the students of Nursery to Std. – IX & XI before their SA 1 & SA-2.]

RULES FOR ISSUE OF EXAM CARD

1. Exam. Card will be issued to student only after the clearance of all the dues before the respective examination.
2. Without Exam. Card no student will be permitted to enter the Examination Hall.
3. Students should collect the Exam. Card from the office, after clearance of all the dues.
4. Rs. 20/- will be charged for issuing a duplicate Exam. Card.
5. Children having less than 85% attendance will not be issued the Exam. Card.

8. ASSIGNMENT SCHEDULE:-

Assignments will be given to students in printed form, three times in a year. Students are supposed to answer all these questions within the time fixed by the Assignment In-charge and concerned teacher to evaluate in time.

9. LEAVE RULES :-

Only students having at least 85% attendance to appear in any of the terminal examinations. Those who fail to fulfil this criteria for any terminal, will be debarred from that terminal examination and marked zero for the same in the mark sheet. Request from the defaulters in this regard will not be entertained. 85% attendance criteria is applicable to each of the examinations separately. Benefits of having more attendance for a particular terminal examination will not be transferred to the other examination. However, Prize for 100% attendance will be given on the basis of the total attendance in an academic year. In case a child remains absent for three consecutive days without permission after a long vacation or in the beginning of the session, his/her name will be struck off the school rolls. For rest of the session absence for six consecutive days, without prior permission will lead to the name of the child being struck off the rolls. Re-admission will be purely at the discretion of the principal and that too with full admission fee. A fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be charged for every unauthorized leave.

Leave may be granted to the students only on the following grounds:

- a) In case of serious illness or death of a very near relative.
- b) For the condolence visit if the student is the only male member of the family and his presence is essential according to the custom.
- c) To attend the marriage of his/her very near relatives.
- d) To perform the Tilak \ Ring ceremony of brother/sister.

10. DISCIPLINE:-

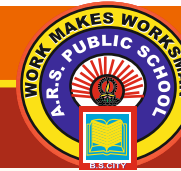
The development of character in education can only be obtained through discipline. The self imposed discipline in punctuality, neatness in dress, behaviour, respect, consideration for other and co-operative spirit are required in each student. Repeated misbehaviour of a student causing harm to himself and other will not be tolerated.

Student without proper school uniform will not be allowed in the school and will be sent back to home. In this case the school disowns all the responsibilities. Pupils are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct and character both in and outside the school. Hence, misbehaviour anywhere justifies dismissal.

11. PUNISHMENT:-

Blue Card - Students who are habitually late or not properly dressed will be put on this card by the House Warden/ Discipline in-charge.

Red Card - Careless and untidy work in academics leads to the award of a red card which has to be signed by the subject teacher on each day of the week during which the student is on the red card. If the progress during the week is satisfactory, the red card will be discontinued.



A student may be terminated whose conduct is against the moral tone of the school. The management's decision regarding the dismissal of a student is final and binding. Parents/Guardians who are applying for their ward's admission to this school are understood to have accepted this condition. The management also reserves the right to suspend a student from attending the school and to determine the period of suspension. The degree of damage caused and the gravity of the incident will be taken into consideration for taking a final decision.

14. LIBRARY:-

The school has set up a large library with reference materials such as books on various subjects, interactive CD's for computer based training, audio and video materials and has a large number of journals & magazines.

15. COMPUTER CENTRE :-

20. STUDENT COUNCIL:-

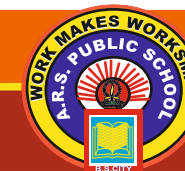
